Re: Voting Open for 2013 LASERS Board of Trustees Election

Date: September 27, 2013

Voting for the 2013 LASERS Board of trustees Election is now open. Below is pertinent information you will need to inform your employees of the election process. Election packets containing candidate platforms, unique voter IDs and Personal Identification Numbers (PINs), and complete voting instructions (including telephone and Internet), were mailed on Monday, September 23, 2013, to all eligible voters in the LASERS member database.

There are three methods in which members can vote in this election:

- **The Internet:** Go to www.vres.us/lasers and follow the instructions on the screen. Active members and retirees must use the unique voter ID and PIN supplied in the election packet to vote via the Internet.
- **Telephone:** To vote by touch-tone phone, active and retiree members call 1.800.218.3626 and follow the automated instructions. Active members and retirees must use the unique voter ID and PIN supplied in the election packet to vote by telephone.
- **Traditional Mail:** Paper ballots are included in the election packet and must be mailed according to the instructions in the packet. If an eligible voter did not receive a ballot, a replacement ballot or voting instructions can be obtained by calling VR Election Services Corporation at 1.800.218.4026, Monday – Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. (Central Time). Members may also email election customer service at custserv@vres.us.

All ballots cast by Internet, telephone, and mail must be received by October 25, 2013 at 4:30 p.m. (Central Time).

The voting process is designed to assure that a member votes only once. Therefore, if a member votes by the Internet or by telephone and also mails a ballot, the first vote received will be the only one counted.
